Personally appears Redding Byers of Dawson County, State of Georgia, who, being duly sworn, says on oath that he is a bona fide citizen and resident of said County and State, and has resided in said State continuously ever since the day of November 1868; that he is 66 years old and by occupation a farmer; that he enlisted in the military service of the Confederate States (or of the State of South Carolina) during the war between the States, and served for the term of nearly 4 years in Company 16th, of 2nd Regiment of South Carolina Volunteers; that his physical condition is as follows: Infirmary age and Poverty

that his property consists of the following items: Household effects

of the value of Ten Dollars. I am now earning by my labor, no Dollars per month. That by reason of his physical condition and poverty he is unable to support himself by his own exertion or labor, and that he receives no pension but the one herein applied for.

Deponent desires to participate in the benefits of the Act approved December 15th, 1894, and the Acts amendatory thereof, and makes application for the pension to which he is entitled for the year 1907. I have heretofore, as a resident of Dawson County, been allowed a pension for the year 1906.
